

Unicorn „Stefanie“

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Materials:

When using the suggested materials, it will be about 22 cm tall.

The listed wool and hook sizes are only suggestions. It is, of course, entirely your personal choice, which yarn you use.

Please keep in mind that different yarn may result in a bigger or smaller piece. Make sure to adapt your hook size according to your yarn and personal tension. When crocheting Amigurumis you should use a much smaller needle size than indicated on the label or you would use it for other crochet projects so that no holes are made when the piece is stuffed.

- Yarn (Sport Weight), e. g. Scheepjes Catona / Schachenmayr Catania - white (about 75g), some black, different colors for mane and tail, some pink for horn and hooves, some gold for the horn - you can make a really big fluffy cuddly toy when you use thick chenille yarn (e. g. Bernat Blanket or a yarn like that)
- Crochet hook in suitable size (with me: 2.0 mm)
- Stuffing

Abbreviations (US Terms):

Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.

Leg (make 2):

White, hook size 2.0 mm

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. **BLO**: sc in each st around (24)
- 6.-11. (6 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
12. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)

Fasten off, don't close, weave in loose ends.

Stuff legs to about $\frac{2}{3}$.

Arm (make 2):

White, hook size 2.0 mm

1. sc 7 in MR (7)
2. inc x7 (14)
3. (sc 1, inc) x7 (21)
4. **BLO**: sc in each st around (21)
- 5.-10. (6 Rounds) sc in each st around (21)
11. (sc 5, dec) x3 (18)

Fasten off, don't close, weave in loose ends.

Stuff legs to about $\frac{2}{3}$.

Body:

White, hook size 2.0 mm

1. sc 7 in MR (7)
2. inc x7 (14)
3. (sc 1, inc) x7 (21)
4. (sc 2, inc) x7 (28)
5. (sc 3, inc) x7 (35)
6. (sc 4, inc) x7 (42)
7. (sc 5, inc) x7 (49)
8. (sc 6, inc) x7 (56)
9. (sc 7, inc) x7 (63)
10. sc in each st around (63)

In the following round the legs are added.

11. sc 15, from the inside through the leg and through the body: sc 9, sc 15, from the inside through the leg and through the body: sc 9, sc 15 (63)
12. sc 15, sc 9 along the unused stitches of the leg: sc 15, sc 9 along the unused stitches of the leg, sc 15 (63)

Move the round marker to the middle of the back if necessary.

13. sc 13, inc, (sc 5, inc) x6, sc 13 (70)
- 14.-25. (12 Rounds) sc in each st around (70)

Move the round marker to the middle of the back if necessary and keep it in that place.

26. sc 17, dec, (sc 5, dec) x5, sc 16 (64)



27. sc 15, *from the inside through the arm and through the body*: sc 9, sc 16, *from the inside through the leg and through the body*: sc 9, sc 15 (64)
28. sc 15, sc 9 *along the unused stitches of the arm*: sc 16, sc 9 *along the unused stitches of the arm*: sc 15 (64)
29. sc 16, (sc 6, dec) x4, sc 16 (60)
30. sc in each st around (60)
31. sc 9, (sc 5, dec) x6, sc 9 (54)
32. sc in each st around (54)
33. sc 15, (sc 2, dec) x6, sc 15 (48)
34. sc in each st around (48)
35. sc 12, (sc 2, dec) x6, sc 12 (42)
36. sc in each st around (42)
37. sc 12, (sc 1, dec) x6, sc 12 (36)
38. sc in each st around (36)
39. sc 9, (loose) slst 18, sc 9 (36)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing, stuff and shape the body.

Head:

White, hook size 2.0 mm

You will start with an oval (see the diagram).


1. ch 10, *starting in 2nd chain from hook*: sc 8, sc 3 in last stitch, rotate 180 degrees and crochet along the opposite side of the foundation chain: sc 7, sc 2 in last stitch (20)
2. inc, sc 7, inc x3, sc 7, inc x2 (26)
3. sc 1, inc, sc 7, (sc 1, inc) x3, sc 7, (sc 1, inc) x2 (32)
4. sc 2, inc, sc 7, (sc 2, inc) x3, sc 7, (sc 2, inc) x2 (38)
5. sc 3, inc, sc 7, (sc 3, inc) x3, sc 7, (sc 3, inc) x2 (44)
6. sc 4, inc, sc 7, (sc 4, inc) x3, sc 7, (sc 4, inc) x2 (50)
7. sc 5, inc, sc 7, (sc 5, inc) x3, sc 7, (sc 5, inc) x2 (56)
8. sc in each st around (56)
9. sc 6, inc, sc 7, (sc 6, inc) x3, sc 7, (sc 6, inc) x2 (62)
- 10.-17. (8 Rounds) sc in each st around (62)
18. (sc 29, dec) x2 (60)
- 19.-21. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (60)
22. (sc 18, dec) x3 (57)
- 23.-25. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (57)
26. (sc 17, dec) x3 (54)
- 27.-29. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (54)
30. (sc 16, dec) x3 (51)
- 31.-32. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (51)
33. (sc 15, dec) x3 (48)
34. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
35. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
36. sc in each st around (36)

Stuff and shape the head.

37. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
38. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
39. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
40. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Finish stuffing.

Crochet an oval



41. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, close, weave in loose ends.

Ear (make 2):

White, hook size 2.0 mm

1. sc 5 in MR (5)
2. inc x5 (10)
3. sc in each st around (10)
4. (sc 1, inc) x5 (15)
- 5.-6. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
7. (sc 2, inc) x5 (20)
- 8.-10. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (20)
11. (sc 2, dec) x5 (15)
12. (sc 1, dec) x5 (10)

Fasten off, don't close, don't stuff, leave a long tail vor sewing.

Horn:

Pink, hook size 2.0 mm


1. sc 5 in MR (5)

BLO from here on:

2. inc, sc 4 (6)
3. inc, sc 5 (7)
4. inc, sc 6 (8)
5. inc, sc 7 (9)
6. inc, sc 8 (10)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Now thread a longer thread through a wool needle (e.g. gold or silver - but you can also use another contrasting color such as white or something like that), make a knot at the end and insert needle from the inside into the tip of the horn towards the outside, right next to the first stitch of the 2nd round. And now always insert from the same side stitch by stitch through the free loops (i.e. wrap around) until you have reached the bottom. Fix the thread and hide it inside, stuff and shape the horn.



Eye (make 2):

White, hook size 2.0 mm

1. sc 7 in MR (7)
2. inc x7 (14)
3. (sc 1, inc) x7 (21)

Color change to black.

4. (loose) slst in each st around (21)
- Fasten off, secure the ends at the back.

Pupil (make 2):

Black, hook size 2.0 mm

1. hdc in MR (10)

Nostrils (make 2):

White, hook size 2.0 mm

1. ch 6, starting in 2nd chain from hook: sc 5 (5)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Horseshoe (make 2 for the legs):

Pink, hook size 2.0 mm

1. ch 15, starting in 2nd chain from hook: sc 14 (14)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Horseshoe (make 2 for the arms):

Pink, hook size 2.0 mm

1. ch 13, starting in 2nd chain from hook: sc 12 (12)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Finishing:

Now place the head on the body, align and fix with pins, then sew together with the end thread of the body (a new thread is also possible). How to do this best is shown in this [Video \(klick\)](#) by PlanetJune.



First place nostrils (slightly bent), ears (flattened), eyes and horn on the head with pins and move until you like it, then sew all parts on (take white thread for the eyes and make sure to only stitch through the white stitches), embroider mouth and eyebrows with black thread, possibly embroider highlights on the pupil with white thread.

Place the horseshoes in the typical shape on legs and arms and sew them in place.

The mane and the tail I have knotted in (latch hooked) with different pastel shades and brushed it until the single threads of the yarn were twirled apart. Of course you can also crochet chains with slip stitches or spiral curls or whatever you like to use here.
