Materials:

When using the suggested materials, it will be about 20 cm tall.

The listed wool and hook sizes are only suggestions. It is, of course, entirely your personal choice, which yarn you use.

Please keep in mind that different yarn may result in a bigger or smaller piece. Make sure to adapt your hook size according to your yarn and personal tension.

- Wool (Sport Weight), e. g. Schachenmayr Catania/Scheepjes Catona (No. 179, 130, some black)
- Crochet hook in suitable size
- Stuffing
- Eyes in suitable size (for me: 10 mm)

Abbreviations (US Terms):

MR = magic ring

inc = increase

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

ch = chain

BLO = back loop only

slst = slip stitch

FLO = front loop only

st = stitch

(-) x = repeat inside of () for x nr of times

Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.

Head:

Main color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)
9. (sc 7, inc) x6 (54)
- 10.-19. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (54)

If you are using safety eyes, attach them between round 12 and 13 with a distance of about 5 stitches.

20. (sc 7, dec) x6 (48)
21. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
22. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
23. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
24. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
25. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)

Stuff and shape the head.

26. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Finish stuffing.

27. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off invisibly.

Snout (Upper part):

Second (maybe lighter) color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 3, inc x3) x2 (18)
4. sc 3, (sc 1, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 1, inc) x3 (24)
5. sc 3, (sc 2, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 2, inc) x3 (30)
- 6.-9. (4 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Snout (Lower part):

Same color as before

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5.-6. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)

Flatten, don't stuff, crochet the edges together with slip stitches.

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Nose:

Black or dark brown

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 3, inc x3) x2 (18)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the nose to the upper part of the snout. You may add a white spot.

Ear (make 2):

Main color

1. sc 7 in MR (7)
2. inc x7 (14)
- 3.-4. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (14)

Flatten, don't stuff, crochet the edges together with slip stitches.

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

optional: Eyelid (make 2):

Main color

1. ch 7, starting in 2nd chain from hook: sc 6 (adapt length to fit the eye if necessary)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing

Finishing the head: Stuff the upper part of the snout and pin it to the lower side of the head (right below the eyes - if you're using safety eyes), the second part of the snout directly below the first part. Mark the spots for the eyes and pin the ears to a nice place. Now take a look if it looks good for you. If you like what you see, remove the lower part of the snout (you can work easier without this piece). Sew the snout to the head (best using mattress stitch) and embroider the black line from the nose down. Pin the lower part again to it's place and sew it on. Sew the ears to the head. If you haven't: attach the eyes (if the toy is a gift for a toddler, you can crochet the eyes - just make a magic ring with sc 6 - and sew them on or embroider the eyes. Don't use glass or plastic eyes for sewing in this case.). Optional: sew on the eyelids. You can attach some threads as hair to the upper middle of the head.



Foot / Leg (make 2):

Main color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
- 6.-10. (5 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)
11. (sc 8, dec) x3 (27)
12. sc 2, dec x4, sc 17 (23)
13. dec x5, sc 13 (18)
14. (sc 4, dec) x3 (15)
15. sc in each st around (15)

Stuff and shape the foot.

16. (sc 4, inc) x3 (18)
- 17.-19. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (18) - *the end of the round should be in the middle of the side of the leg (see right picture) - move the end if necessary (I've made 2 stitches less in the last round).*

First (left - when you look from behind) leg: fasten off invisibly.

Don't fasten off the second leg, the legs will be connected next.



Body:

20. *Hold the legs together, have a look that the feet points straight to the front.*
ch 3, sc 1 into the first made (left) leg, sc 17 around this leg, sc 3 along the chain, sc 18 around the second made (right) leg, sc 3 along the chain (42)

First round of the body is ready now, don't forget to place your new round marker now. If you haven't exactly 42 stitches now - no problem. You can adapt it in the next round by increase or decrease the needed stitches.

21. sc in each st around (42)
22. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)
- 23.-24. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (48)
25. sc 16, inc, (sc 1, inc) x5, sc 21 (54)
26. sc in each st around (54)
27. sc 17, inc, (sc 2, inc) x5, sc 21 (60)

You can add a belly button in round 33 - or embroider it later, both looks good. You can also omit the belly button.

If you wanna make one: make a bobble stitch using dc 3 in the middle above the legs (for me 28th stitch - this may vary). Bobble/cluster stitch is shown in the video for the toes of the „Baby Stummelchen“ (click) at my page in the „Tips, tricks, tutorials“ section.

28.-37. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (60)

Stuff the legs.

38. sc 17, dec, (sc 2, dec) x5, sc 21 (54)

39. sc in each st around (54)

40. (sc 7, dec) x6 (48)

41. sc in each st around (48)

42. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)

43. sc in each st around (42)

Add more stuffing.

44. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)

45. sc in each st around (36)

46. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)

47.-48. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)

49. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)

50.-52. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Stuff and shape the body, place the head to the body and fix it, if it looks good for you, sew the head to the body (best using mattress stitch). You may stuff again before finally closing.



Arm (make 2):

Main color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5.-9. (5 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
10. (sc 6, dec) x3 (21)
11. sc in each st around (21)
12. (sc 5, dec) x3 (18)
13. sc in each st around (18)

Stuff the paw but not too tightly so you can form it well later.

14. (sc 4, dec) x3 (15)
- 15.-16. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
17. (sc 3, dec) x3 (12)
- 18.-25. (8 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

Slightly stuff the arm.

26. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Now sculpt the paws using black yarn. I like to use pins as guidelines and to help the yarn glide nicely. Insert your needle from the bottom, just behind the first pinhead (leaving a tail), guide the yarn around the front to the pin on the top of the paw, pull tight and adjust the tension if needed. Now repeat this step, but start on the second pin on top. Bring your needle out just behind the top pinhead, feed the yarn down to the other pin, again pulling and adjusting tension to achieve the desired form, and exiting your needle through your initial point of entry. Adjust your tension, once more, as needed and knot both ends well. The tails can be pulled back into the paw to hide them. See photos for reference.



Attach the arms to the left and right directly under the head.

Tail:

Main color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
- 3.-5. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

Stuff slightly, flatten at the top and crochet together with slip stitches, fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew on the tail at an appropriate place.



Granny style scarf:

Hook size as indicated at the label.

The scarf is crocheted in rows. At the end of each row, chain 3 (counts as a dc) and turn.

1. MR (or: ch 4, join ring with a slst), in the ring: ch 4, dc 3, ch 3, dc 3, ch 1, dc 1, ch 3, turn
2. ch 1, dc 3 in the chain space, ch 1, (dc 3, ch 3, dc 3) in the chain space, ch 1, dc 3 in the chain space, ch 1, dc 1 in the 3rd ch of the previous row, ch 3, turn
3. ch 1, (dc 3 in the chain space, ch 1) < - repeat all into the brackets until you reach the 3 chains on the tip of the scarf, (dc 3, ch 3, dc 3) in the chain space, ch 1, (dc 3 in the chain space, ch 1) < - repeat all into the brackets until you reach the end of the row, dc 1 in the 3rd ch of the previous row, ch 3, turn

Repeat row 3 until you reach the desired size of the scarf.

For a nice finish you can crochet a row single crochets around the scarf.
