

Little Blobb



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Materials:

- Scraps of wool (you can use all your little scraps of wool to making the little blobb, but you should use wool of nearly the same weight)
- Crochet hook in suitable size
- Stuffing
- optional: Eyes in suitable size - you can also embroider the eyes

Abbreviations (US Terms):

MR = magic ring

inc = increase

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

ch = chain

BLO = back loop only

slst = slip stitch

FLO = front loop only

st = stitch

(-) x = repeat inside of () for x nr of times

Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.

Head / body:

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
- 6.-10. (5 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)

If you're using safety eyes, attach them between round 7 and 8 with a distance of 3-4 stitches.

11. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
12. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
13. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Stuff.

14. (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)
15. inc x9 (18)
- 16.-18. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (18)
19. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Finish stuffing.

20. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off invisibly.

Foot (make 2):

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
- 3.-5. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)
6. dec x6 (6)

Do not stuff, fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Arm (make 2):

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. (sc 1, inc) x3 (9)
3. (sc 1, dec) x3 (6)
- 4.-5. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (6)

Do not stuff, fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew feet and arms on the body (see picture), embroider face (maybe also the eyes), latch hook some threads of wool if you like and bang! your little Blobb is ready :o)

You can crochet a hat for your blobb if you want.

Hat (optional):

Can be worked in ether continuous or joined rounds (join each round with a slst and chain 1). I chose a bigger hook size. If you're using the same size, add 1 or 2 more rounds with increases. Just try on the hat :o)

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5.-13. (9 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)

Fasten off invisibly. Just roll up the edge a bit.
