Materials:

When using the suggested materials, it will be about 18 cm long.

The listed wool and hook sizes are only suggestions. It is, of course, entirely your personal choice, which yarn you use.

Please keep in mind that different yarn may result in a bigger or smaller piece. Make sure to adapt your hook size according to your yarn and personal tension.

- Wool (Sport Weight), e. g. Schachenmayr Catania / Scheepjes Catona (No. 263 or 255, 208, 110, 100, 128, 212, some white, some black fluffy wool for the hair)
- Crochet hook in suitable size (for me: 2.0 mm and for the fluffy wool: 5 mm)
- Stuffing
- Some pipe cleaner

Abbreviations (US Terms):

MR = magic ring	inc = increase
sc = single crochet	dec = decrease
dc = double crochet	BLO = back loop only

slst = slip stitch	st = stitch

Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.

Head:

Skin color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
 2. inc x6 (12)
 3. (sc 3, inc x3) x2 (18)
 4. sc 3, (sc 1, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 1, inc) x3 (24)
 5. sc 3, (sc 2, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 2, inc) x3 (30)
 6. sc 3, (sc 3, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 3, inc) x3 (36)
 7. sc 3, (sc 4, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 4, inc) x3 (42)
 8. sc 3, (sc 5, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 5, inc) x3 (48)
 9. sc 3, (sc 6, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 6, inc) x3 (54)
 - 10.-24. (15 Rounds) sc in each st around (54)
 25. (sc 7, dec) x6 (48)
 26. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
 27. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
 28. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
 29. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
- Stuff and shape the head.*
30. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
 31. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Finish stuffing.

32. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off invisibly.

Hair:

Black fluffy wool

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)

Fasten off. Brush the fluff on one side and sew it to the head.

Alternatively you can also latch hook the hair as usual with normal wool.

Eye (make 2):

White

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Pupil (make 2):

Black

1. sc 6 in MR (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Place pupil on eye and sew in place with black thread. Embroider a highlight with one of the two white threads (if one is shorter, the shorter one), sew the eye to the head with the other white thread.

Nose:

Black

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 3, inc) x3 (15)
- 4.-6. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
7. (sc 3, dec) x3 (12)

Fasten off, do not close, leave a long tail for sewing.

Stuff nose and sew it on the head.

Antennae (make 2):

Black

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 3, inc) x3 (15)
- 4.-6. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
7. (sc 3, dec) x3 (12)

Stuff the little ball.

8. dec x6 (6)

Color change to yellow

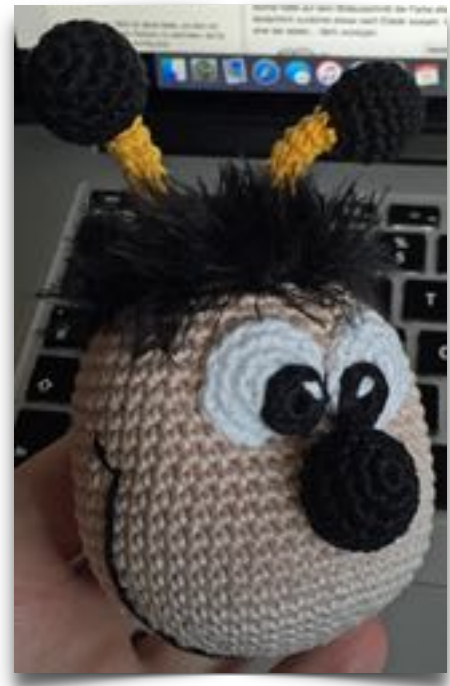
- 9.-18. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (6) - 60 stitches continuously counted

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Insert pipe cleaner.

Sew the antennae on the head.

Embroider the mouth.



Body:

Black

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
 2. (sc 1, inc) x3 (9)
 3. (sc 2, inc) x3 (12)
 4. sc in each st around (12)
 5. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
 6. sc in each st around (18)
 7. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- Color change to yellow, from here the color changes after every 4th round, so always 4 rounds yellow, 4 rounds black, I don't mention this.*
8. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
 9. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
 10. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)
 11. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)
 12. (sc 7, inc) x6 (54)
 - 13.-15. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (54)
 16. (sc 8, inc) x6 (60)
 - 17.-19. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (60)
 20. (sc 9, inc) x6 (66)
 - 21.-23. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (66)
 24. (sc 10, inc) x6 (72)
 - 25.-29. (5 Rounds) sc in each st around (72)
 30. (sc 10, dec) x6 (66)
 - 31.-32. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (66)

33. (sc 9, dec) x6 (60)
34. sc in each st around (60)
35. (sc 8, dec) x6 (54)

Last color change to black here.

36. (sc 7, dec) x6 (48)
37. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
38. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
39. sc in each st around (36)
40. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
41. sc in each st around (30)

Fasten off, do not close, leave a long tail for sewing.

Stuff and shape the body and sew the head and body together (best using mattress stitch).

Foot (make 2):

Skin color

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5.-8. (4 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
9. (sc 6, dec) x3 (21)
10. sc in each st around (21)
11. (sc 5, dec) x3 (18)
12. sc in each st around (18)
13. (sc 4, dec) x3 (15)
- 14.-16. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)

Stuff the foot.

17. (sc 1, dec) x5 (10)
18. dec x5 (5)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Leg (make 2):

Skin color

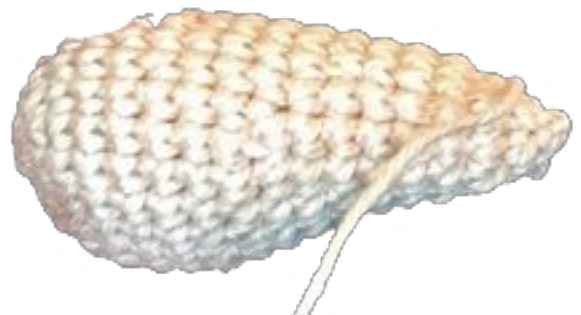
1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. **BLO**: sc in each st around (12)
4. sc in each st around (12)
5. (sc 3, inc) x3 (15)
- 6.-7. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
8. dec x3, sc 3, inc x3, sc 3 (15)
9. sc in each st around (15)
10. inc x3, sc 3, dec x3, sc 3 (15)
11. sc in each st around (15)
12. (sc 4, inc) x3 (18)
- 13.-14. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (18)
15. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Stuff and shape the leg.

16. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew foot and leg together (best using mattress stitch).



Thumb (make 4):

Skin color

1. ch 3, join round with slst
 2. inc x3 (6)
 - 3.-4. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (6)
- Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

Finger (make 8):

Skin color

1. ch 3, join round with slst
 2. sc 1, inc x2 (5)
 - 3.-5. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (5)
- Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

Little finger (make 4):

Skin color

1. ch 3, join round with slst
 2. sc 1, inc x2 (5)
 - 3.-4. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (5)
- First only make 1 little finger, do **not!** cut the yarn. Only after one arm has been completed, crochet the next little finger.*

Now take the little finger and 2 of the larger fingers and crochet as follows:

Right Hand / Arm (make 2):

Skin color

1. sc 2 along the little finger, sc 2 along the middle finger, sc 5 along the next finger, sc 3 along the middle finger, sc 3 along the little finger (15)
2. sc in each st around (15)
3. sc 4, now insert hook from the inside through a stitch on thumb and through the next stitch of hand and sc 1, repeat once (let the remaining 3 stitches of thumb unworked for now), sc 9 along the hand (15)



4. sc 4, sc 3 around the unworked stitches of the thumb, sc 9 (16)
5. sc 14, dec (15)

Stuff the hand. You can insert some pipe cleaner in the fingers so that they are moveable later.

6. (sc 1, dec) x5 (10)
7. (sc 4, inc) x2 (12)
- 8.-10. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (12).
11. inc, sc 3, dec x2, sc 3, inc (12)
12. sc in each st around (12)
13. dec, sc 3, inc x2, sc 3, dec (12)
- 14.-16. (4 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

Stuff and shape the arm.

17. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Left Hand / Arm (make 2):

Skin color

1. sc 2 along the little finger, sc 2 along the middle finger, sc 5 along the next finger, sc 3 along the middle finger, sc 3 along the little finger (15)
2. sc in each st around (15)
3. sc 7, now insert hook from the inside through a stitch on thumb and through the next stitch of hand and sc 1, repeat once (let the remaining 3 stitches of thumb unworked for now), sc 6 along the hand (15)
4. sc 7, sc 3 around the unworked stitches of the thumb, sc 6 (16)
5. sc 14, dec (15)

Stuff the hand. You can insert some pipe cleaner in the fingers so that they are moveable later.

6. (sc 1, dec) x5 (10)
7. (inc, sc 4) x2 (12)
- 8.-10. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (12).
11. inc, sc 3, dec x2, sc 3, inc (12)
12. sc in each st around (12)
13. dec, sc 3, inc x2, sc 3, dec (12)
- 14.-16. (4 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

Stuff and shape the arm.

17. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew all the arms and the legs on the body.

Wings:

White

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. sc in each st around (18)
5. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 6.-11. (6 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
12. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
13. sc in each st around (18)
14. (sc 2, dec) x6 (12)
15. sc in each st around (12)
16. (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)
17. sc in each st around (9)
18. (sc 2, inc) x3 (12)
19. sc in each st around (12)

20. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
21. sc in each st around (18)
22. (sc 3, inc) x6 (24)
- 23.-28. (6 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
29. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
30. sc in each st around (18)
31. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)
32. dec x6 (6)

*Fasten off invisible. Do not stuff the wings but flatten it.
Sew the wings on an appropriate place at body.*

Flower:

Part 1:

Light yellow

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
 2. inc x6 (12)
 3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
 4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
 - 5.-7. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
- Color change to green.*
8. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
 9. sc in each st around (18)
 10. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)
 - 11.-12. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

Stuff it.

13. (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)
- 14.-15. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (9)
16. (sc 1, dec) x3 (6)
- 17.-51. (35 Rounds) sc in each st around (6) - sc 210 continuously counted

Fasten off, insert some pipe cleaner, close and weave in the end. If the stem is unstable with the pipe cleaner, use a wooden stick instead or something like that.



Flower petal (make 6):

Color of choice

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5.-8. (4 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
9. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
10. sc in each st around (18)
11. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

Fold in half, don't stuff, close top with a row of sc.

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

I left a longer thread on one petal and weaved in the thread on the others. With the longer thread I sewed on all the petals - a little overlapping. Of course you can also sew on each petal with its own thread.



Lower part of the flower:

Green

Crochet in joined rounds (join each round with a slst and chain 1).

1. ch 18, join round with a slst. ch 1, sc in each st, slst in 1st st, ch 1 (18)
2. (sc 2, inc) x6, slst in 1st st, ch 1 (24)
3. (skip 1, dc 7 in next st, skip 1, slst in next st) x6

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Insert the stem through the hole and sew the newly created wreath of leaves directly under the flower to the stem.



Leave:

Green

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. (sc 1, inc) x3 (9)
3. sc in each st around (9)
4. (sc 2, inc) x3 (12)
5. (sc 3, inc) x3 (15)
6. sc in each st around (15)
7. (sc 4, inc) x3 (18)
8. sc in each st around (18)
9. (sc 5, inc) x3 (21)
10. (sc 6, inc) x3 (24)
11. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
- 12.-18. (7 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)
19. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
20. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
21. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)
22. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Flatten the leave, don't stuff, sew the leave on the stem.
