## **Materials:**

*When using the suggested materials, the blanket will be about 30 x 30 cm.*

*The listed wool and hook sizes are only suggestions. It is, of course, entirely your personal choice, which yarn you use.*

*Please keep in mind that different yarn may result in a bigger or smaller piece. Make sure to adapt your hook size according to your yarn and personal tension. When crocheting Amigurumis you should use a much smaller needle size than indicated on the label or you would use it for other crochet projects so that no holes are made when the piece is stuffed.*

- Wool (Sport / DK), with me for blanket, collar and cap: The Cotton Wool (Pima cotton) of „We are knitters“ - of course it does not have to be Pima cotton, e.g. DROPS Paris would be a good and cheap alternative, for the head: Schachenmayr Catania No. 263 or Scheepjes Catona No. 255, a small amount of black for the eyes, some threads of white
- Crochet hook in suitable size (with me: 2.0 mm for the head, 5.0 mm for blanket, collar and cap)
- Stuffing

## **Abbreviations (US Terms):**

MR = magic ring	inc = increase
sc = single crochet	dec = decrease
dc = double crochet	BLO = back loop only
ch = chain	FLO = front loop only
slst = slip stitch	st = stitch
(-) x = repeat inside of ( ) for x nr of times	

*Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.*

## **Blanket:**

*Color of choice, hook size as indicated at the label*

*Crochet in rows. At the end of each row, chain 1 and turn.*

*Of course you can use each pattern you like for the blanket.*

1. ch 69, sc 1 in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, skip 2, \*(sc 1, ch 1, dc 1) in next ch, skip 2\*, repeat between \*\*, ending with sc in last st, turn
2. ch 1, \*(sc 1, ch 1, dc 1) in next chain space\*, repeat between \*\*, ending with sc in last st, turn

*The second row is repeated until the desired size is reached.*

*Finally I bordered the whole blanket, I worked a slst 1, ch 1 alternately, weave in loose ends. Of course you can design the finish as you like, e.g. only sc, picots or similar.*

## **Head:**

*Skin color, hook size 2.0 mm*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)
9. (sc 7, inc) x6 (54)
10. (sc 8, inc) x6 (60)
- 11.-20. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (60)
21. (sc 8, dec) x6 (54)
22. (sc 7, dec) x6 (48)
23. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
24. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
25. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
26. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
27. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)

*Stuff and shape the head.*

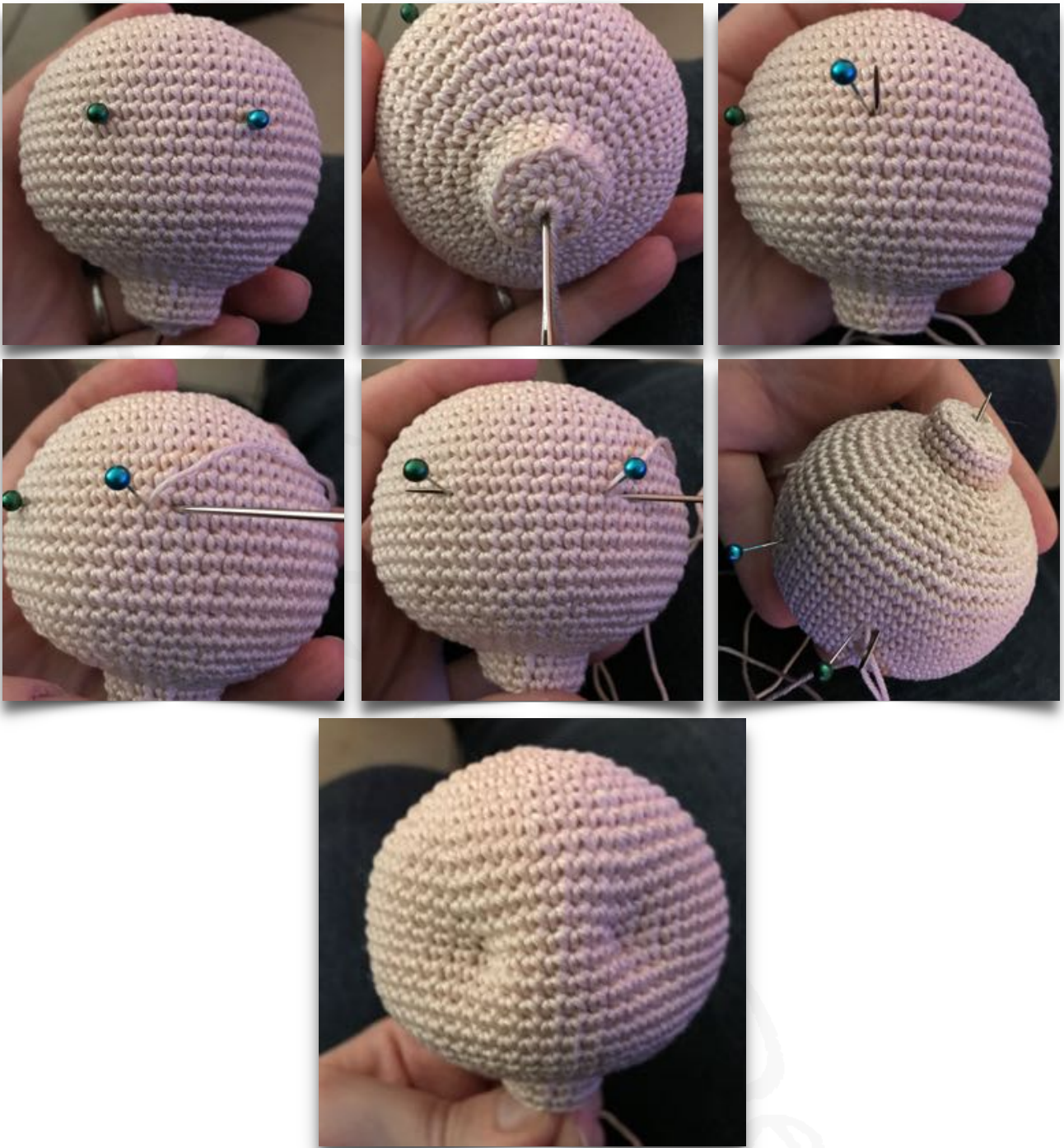
28. **FLO**: sc in each st around (18)
- 29.-30. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (18)
31. **BLO**: (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)

*Finish stuffing.*

32. dec x6 (6)

*Fasten off, close, weave in loose ends.*

*If you like, you can shape eye sockets. For this, mark the spots for the eyes with pins. Use a sufficiently long needle to insert from below through the head to the first mark, offset one stitch to the left or right and come out at the second mark. Insert again offset by one stitch and come out at the bottom at the starting point. Now gently tighten the thread until the desired eye sockets are formed (as evenly as possible), secure the thread at the bottom with several knots and weave in loose ends.*



### **Eye (make 2):**

*Black, hook size 2.0 mm*

*For the eye: sc 7 in MR, fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*Attach the eyes to the head, I've placed the bottom of the eye between round 14 and 15 with 6-8 stitches in between.*

## Collar:

*Color of choice, hook size as indicated at the label*

*Crochet in rows.*

1. ch 18, *starting in 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from hook*: dc 1, dc 2 in each other chain, turn
2. skip 1, dc 5 in next st, (skip 1, sc 1 in next st, skip 1, dc 5 next st) < - repeat inside the brackets until you have 2 stitches left: skip 1, slst 1 in last st, turn
3. ch 1, sc 1, \*(ch 2, sc 1) x5, slst 1\* < - repeat between \*\* until the end of the row

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*The collar is now sewn to the bottom of the neck.*

## Cap:

*Color of choice, hook size as indicated at the label*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. sc in each st around (6)
3. (sc 1, inc) x3 (9)
- 4.-5. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (9)
6. (sc 2, inc) x3 (12)
- 7.-8. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)
9. (sc 3, inc) x3 (15)
- 10.-11. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
12. (sc 4, inc) x3 (18)
- 13.-14. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (18)
15. (sc 5, inc) x3 (21)
- 16.-17. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (21)
18. (sc 6, inc) x3 (24)
- 19.-20. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
21. (sc 7, inc) x3 (27)
- 22.-23. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (27)
24. (sc 8, inc) x3 (30)
- 25.-26. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (30)
27. (sc 9, inc) x3 (33)
- 28.-29. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (33)
30. (sc 10, inc) x3 (36)
- 31.-32. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (36)
33. (sc 11, inc) x3 (39)
- 34.-35. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (39)
36. (sc 12, inc) x3 (42)
- 37.-41. (5 Rounds) sc in each st around (42)
42. alternately until the end of the round: slst 1, ch 1

*Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.*

*Try on the cap while crocheting. In between check when the cap fits loosely on the head, if this is the case earlier, simply crochet the 5 rounds of sc instead of the 2 rounds and then the final round. If it does not fit loosely over the head in round 37, simply continue working in the same style (increase 3 stitches in each round and then 2 rounds without increases until the cap fits. Then crochet the 5 rounds without increases and the final round.*





*Sew the cap on the head.  
Fold the blanket twice and mark the  
tip, so that you have the middle of the  
blanket. Sew on the head at this point,  
preferably with a thread in the same  
color.*

*Now the lovey is done :o)*
